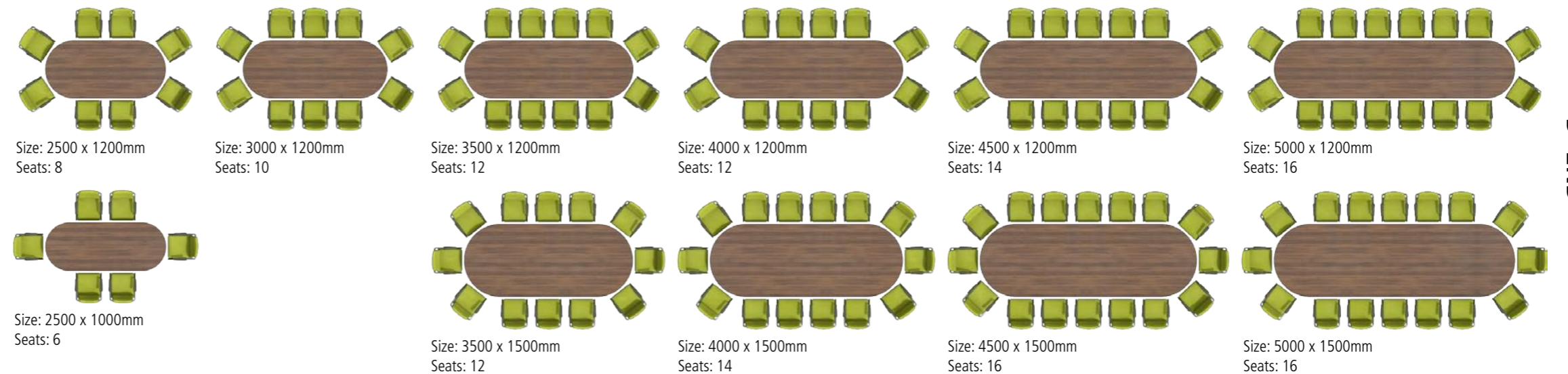
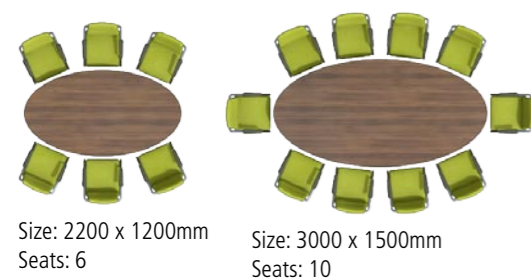
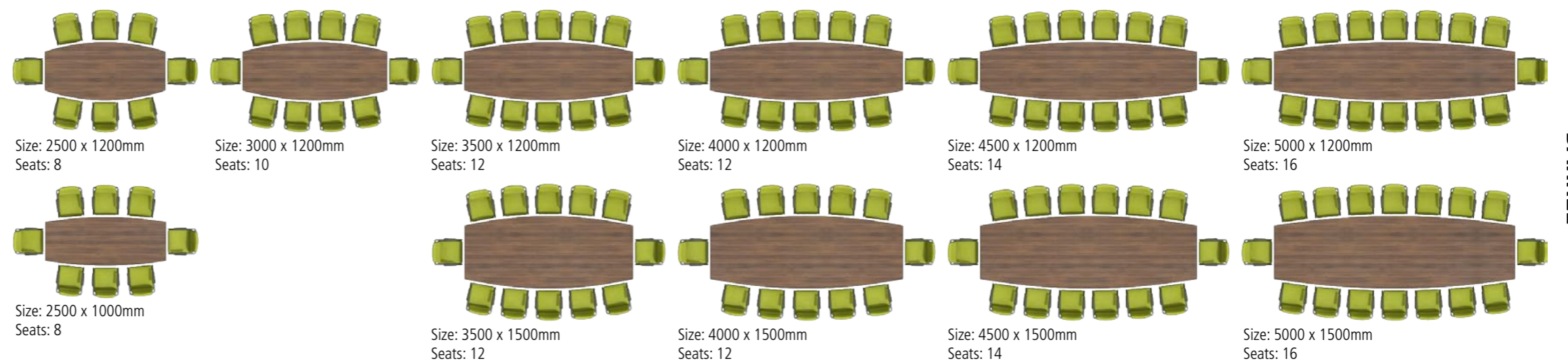
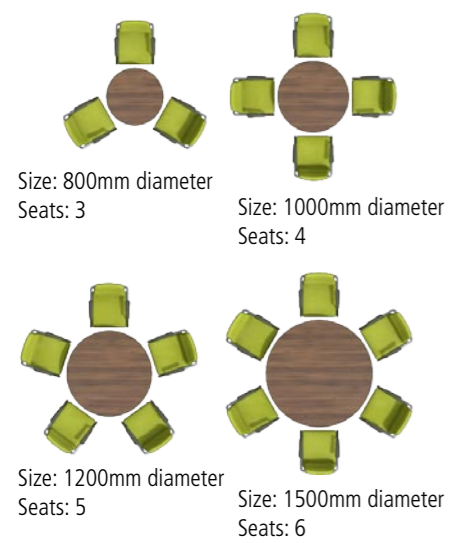
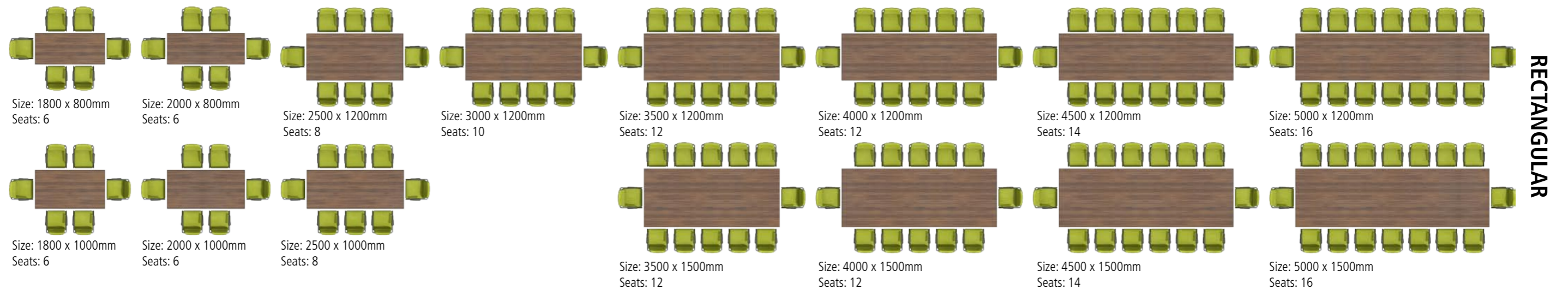


AMBUS TABLES SEATING GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION ON THE NUMBER OF BASES ON EACH TABLE



In the second column below we indicate the number of pieces in which the top is manufactured. On one-piece table tops the grain of the MFC/veneer runs end to end; on multiple-piece table tops the grain on veneer runs side to side and on MFC runs end to end. Columns 3-6 below list the number of bases supplied with each table size. All tables are 735mm high.

Table tops in two pieces on I-Frames, 'T', Pedestal, Panel, Twin square column and Box bases have a supporting base at the join between the table segments. Please take account of the visual effect this will have, and the possible impact on the seating layout (Arrowhead bases have reinforcing support rails across the join on two piece tables).

These seating capacity illustrations are intended to provide an initial guide – but please make your own calculations based on the actual dimensions of the chairs you will be using and the amount of space you wish to provide for each person. These illustrations are based on Sven Fulcrum or G-Series armchairs.
